The ancient farmers took some steps to greatly increase the surface runoff.

Their steps included two main components:


- They cleared stones on the slope's surface to allow uninterrupted flow of runoff.
- They built accumulation ditches along the slopes to collect the runoff before seeping into the ground.

They constructed **systems of terraced plots** along the wadi.

They built, in larger wadis, complex systems including dams, diversion channels and supporting walls.
